



Advanced Supervision Workshop Working Creatively

An experiential 1-day workshop relevant for experienced supervisors who want to develop their creativity in their 1:1 and group supervision practice. Participants will be given the opportunity to experience working with a wide range of materials, which can act as springboards for deeper reflection, new insights and broader conversations. Previous attendance to 'Are you getting enough (1), (2) and (3)?' is required. Exact course content will be negotiated with course participants to ensure relevant skills development, practice opportunities and innovative resources. Group number is limited to 9, so early booking is recommended

Potential topics include:

- Image work e.g. photographs, blob people, drawing
- 3D materials e.g. buttons, stones, drawing, clay, sand
- Using visual frameworks e.g. lifestyle grid, importance jars
- Working with metaphor
- Skills practice in pairs, triads and groups
- Collaborative trouble shooting of supervision practice issues
- Next steps for self-care and professional development
- Options for the development of an on-going supervision practice group
